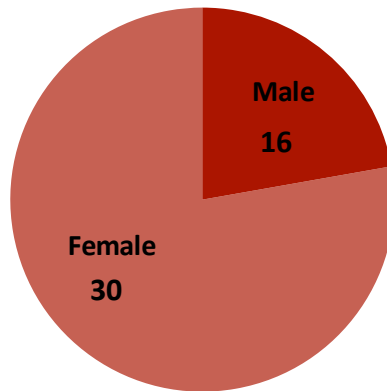

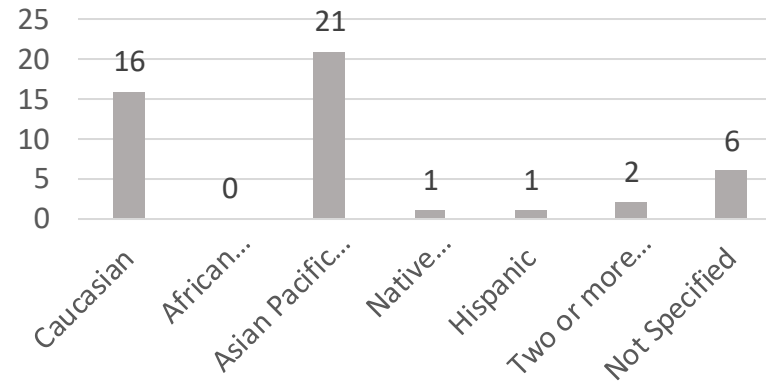
Class of 2028 by the numbers

Students by Gender (46)



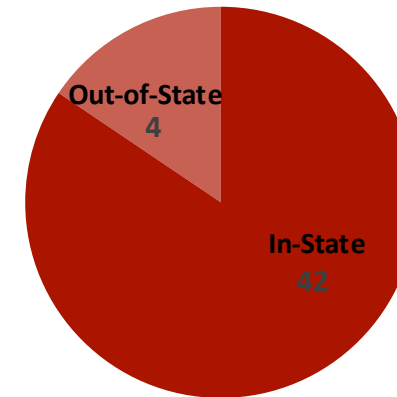

Thomas Manders, BS '87, DDS '91, director of the Division of Endodontics and Advanced Education Program in Endodontics, has been promoted to clinical associate professor in the Department of Periodontics and Endodontics.

Manders has been a member of the faculty at Stony Brook since 2016, having joined as a clinical assistant professor and director of the dental student endodontics curriculum, while also providing care in the school's faculty practice. He began to oversee resident curricula the following year. Before returning to his alma mater, Manders spent more than two decades owning and operating private endodontic practices in New York City and Stamford, Connecticut.

Upon completing his Doctor of Dental Surgery at Stony Brook, Manders earned his general practice residency certificate at Danbury Hospital in Danbury, Connecticut, and his endodontics certificate at the University of Medicine and Dentistry of New Jersey. He has been a diplomate of the American Board of Endodontics since 2018, and a fellow of the International College of Dentists since 2019.



Mahdian Promoted to Associate Professor with Tenure

Mina Mahdian, DDS, MDSc, a faculty member in Stony Brook's Department of Prosthodontics and Digital Technology since 2015 and current program director for the Advanced Education Program in Oral and Maxillofacial Radiology, has been promoted to associate professor with tenure.

In addition to her role in academia, Mahdian has been active in research, with a focus on advanced imaging, optical coherence tomography, radiation

dosimetry and artificial intelligence. She maintains memberships on many SDM committees and provides radiology consultation to faculty in the SDM and practitioners in the community.

Mahdian earned her Doctor of Dental Surgery from Shahid Beheshti University of Medical Sciences School of Dentistry in Tehran, Iran, and completed her Master of Dental Science and OMFR residency from the University of Connecticut.



Tanya Somohano Marquez, DMD, has been promoted to clinical associate professor in the Department of Prosthodontics and Digital Technology. She joined the SDM in 2015 as a full-time faculty member, and shortly after was appointed to direct the prosthodontic residency program.

Board-certified in prosthodontics, Somohano-Marquez has authored or co-authored numerous publications that have been published in prestigious journals, including in the April 2024 edition of the *Journal of Prosthodontics*. Her research efforts resulted in being awarded the SDM's Sydney and Edith Golub Endowed Memorial Fund for Faculty Development in 2018.

Somohano-Marquez earned her Doctor of Dental Medicine from the University of Puerto Rico, and continued her training at a two-year general practice residency at Bronx Lebanon Hospital in New York. She completed her prosthodontics specialty training at New York University College of Dentistry in New York City, and then a fellowship in maxillofacial prosthodontics and UCLA Dentistry in Los Angeles, California.



Jerome Cymerman, DMD, who began his career at Stony Brook University in 1985, was promoted to the rank of clinical associate professor in the Department of Periodontics and Endodontics. His tenure at the SDM has included serving as director of the Division of Endodontics, as well as director of the Advanced Dental Education Program in Endodontics.

Cymerman received his DMD from University of Pennsylvania School of Dental Medicine. He went on to complete a general practice residency at University of Miami School of Medicine's Jackson Memorial Hospital location, and then his certificate in endodontics at Nassau University Medical Center in East Meadow, New York. Cymerman is a diplomate of the American Board of Endodontics, and has been in private endodontic practice for over 30 years.

In addition to instructing endodontic residents, Cymerman has been a mentor for their research endeavors. His own research interests include cone-beam computed tomography, pain control and the testing of antimicrobial medications in root canal therapy.



Srinivas Myneni, BDS, MS, PhD, director of the SDM's advanced dental education program in periodontics and director of periodontal research, has been promoted to associate professor with tenure in the Department of Periodontics and Endodontics.

Myneni completed his bachelor's in dental surgery in 2005 at Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences in Bengaluru, India. After finishing his clinical training, he moved to the United States to pursue a dual PhD/periodontics residency program at University at Buffalo School of Dental Medicine. He came to Stony Brook as a full-time faculty member in 2015, and has made significant contributions to the school in academics, research and community service.

Myneni's research and clinical programs focus on novel therapies for the treatment of periodontitis and peri-implantitis and the influence of circadian rhythm on oral health and disease. He has contributed to 25 manuscripts, eight as a major or senior author, all appearing in well-respected journals. He also helped prepare two book chapters, one of which was in the most used text in periodontology internationally.
