The Artificial Intelligence Revolution

How AI can improve periodontal disease diagnosis

ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE has become integrated into nearly every aspect of everyday life, and it is no surprise that it is influencing the field of dentistry. AI shows strong potential to help diagnose and treat periodontal disease, a chronic inflammatory condition that causes gum damage and alveolar bone loss. As early and accurate detection is essential for preventing long-term complications, AI-enhanced tools may represent a significant advancement for periodontal care.

The role of AI in periodontal disease detection and classification

The traditional method for periodontal disease diagnosis relies on clinical examination for signs of disease through periodontal probing pocket depth, clinical attachment loss, and bleeding on probing. However, the results of these tests can vary due to clinician technique and subjective interpretation, which can lead to inconsistencies or inaccuracies in diagnosis or staging.

A 2025 literature review analyzed 13 studies demonstrating that AI and deep learning technologies show strong performance in periodontal disease diagnosis, risk assessment, treatment planning, and prognosis. AI models applied to panoramic, periapical, or full-mouth radiographs demonstrated strong diagnostic performance, with accuracy rates ranging from 73-98.6%.

Most notably, AI models involving convolutional neural networks and hybrid frameworks — which combine deep learning for detection with conventional computer-aided diagnostic methods for classification — showed the highest accuracy in automatically detecting periodontal bone levels and staging periodontitis. CNNs were highly effective in detecting and quantifying alveolar bone loss, achieving accuracy rates as high as 92%. Hybrid models produced excellent reliability in detecting periodontal bone levels and staging periodontitis, indicating that AI can support clinicians with precise and reproducible assessments.

AI's advantages

The high diagnostic performance of AI with deep learning technologies represents a significant advancement for periodontal disease detection and staging. Traditional clinical measures such as PPD, CAL, and BOP can vary based on clinician technique and subjectivity, leading to inconsistent and potentially inaccurate diagnoses. Additionally, these techniques are time-consuming, as they require probing of each tooth site, a process that can be uncomfortable for the patient and may reduce compliance with complete periodontal charting.

In contrast, AI models analyze radiographic data objectively and consistently, reducing human error and improving diagnostic
